### Note from the Chairmen -----

Regular users of Highfield Hall will know that the chairs and tables have to be put up and taken down at each Workshop. There seem to be as many ways to store these items as there are chairs. But it would be useful if we could please adhere to the following arrangements: -

- i) Stack the chairs a MAXIMUM of 6 high. (*Health and Safety requirement*)
- ii) Store the chairs adjacent to our Notice Board in the main room. (*Putting them near our cupboards causes problems.*)
- iii) **Please** store an absolute minimum of additional items near the tables. **We had a quite serious and dangerous collapse of easels, tubes and the "portrait platform" a few weeks ago onto one of our artists when accessing the tables.**
