



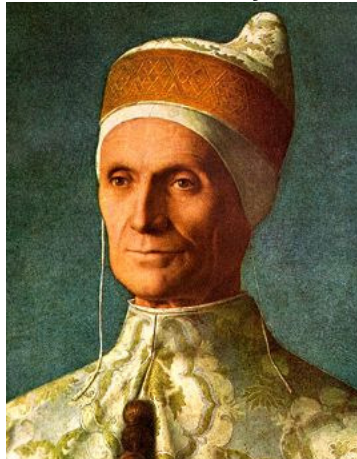
Monthly Competition
